 - While most of the misuse could be solved without the help of our trademark lawyer, for some cases we needed their assistance

WHAT WE DO

- Process optimization

PROCESS OPTIMIZATION

Reasons:

- Large amount of continuing domain infringements (10-15 domain infringements per month)
- Large amount of existing domains to monitor (after cleanup 456 domains)
- Risk of duplication

What we do:

- We automated to check if a domain is in use or not via an automated check. Only when it is live, we do a manual and visual check.
- We check for duplicates because it happens that domains are brought to us multiple times

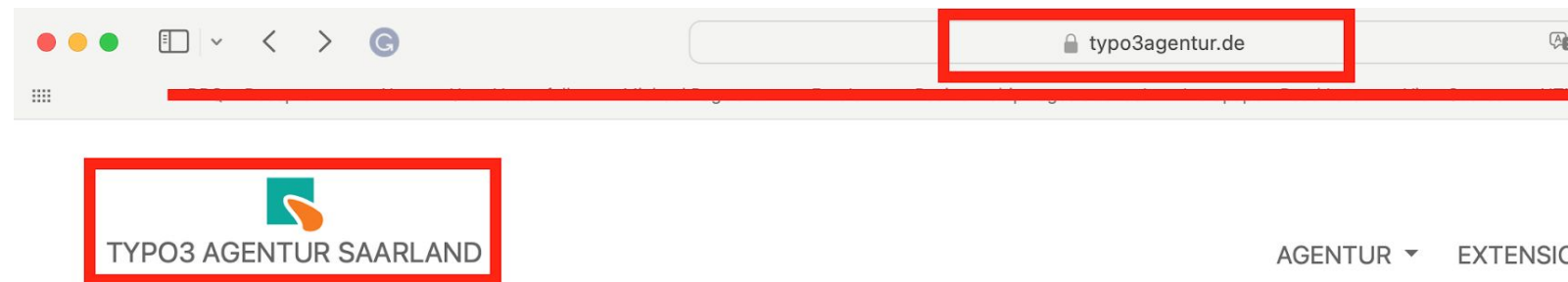

DOMAIN AND OTHER INFRINGEMENTS

- We monitor 456 domains, of which 158 domains are active
- Of those 158 domains, we classified them as follows
- 30 for sale
- 10 not reachable
- 56 are some sort of server message, under development etc.
- 6 are spam/sex/gamble site
- 6 are community effort meaning they support some sort of community-driven development/initiative
- 12 redirect to TYP03.org
- 38 are under investigation or pre-legal action

OPPOSITION

We started 1 opposition against someone filing a trademark registration for “typon”. We expect a result mid-July of this year.

A limited statutory examination consists primarily of inquiries of entity personnel and analytical procedures as well as detailed tests of entity documents as considered necessary in the circumstances. 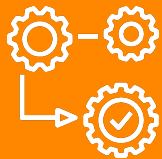

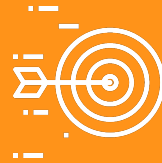

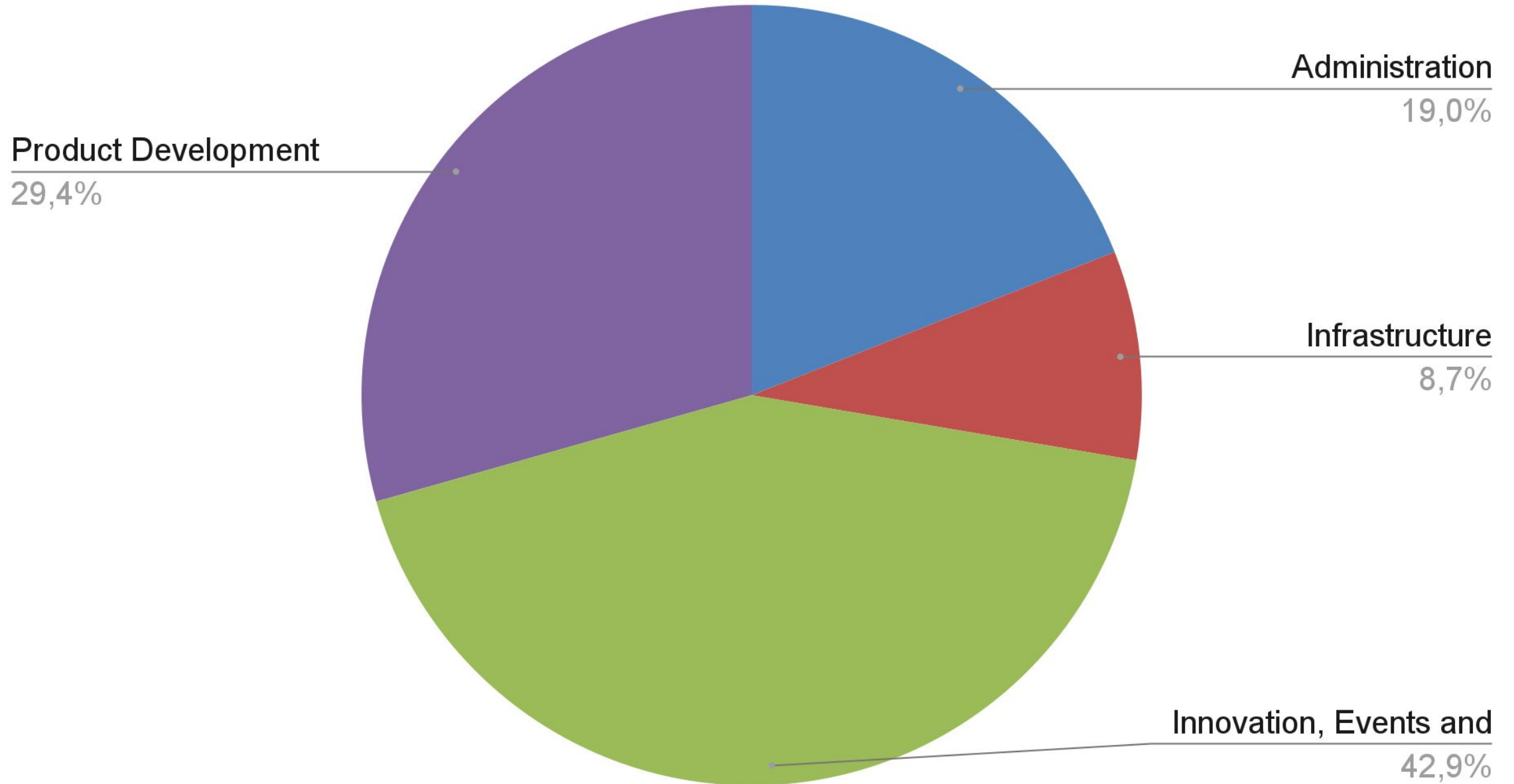
