Inspect GET and POST parameters and session data of powermail forms.
The extension is useful, if you want to controll the workflow of your extension depending of the status of a powermail form (create, edit, send). And it is useful, if need data of a powermail form.
It is compatible with powermail 1.x and 2.x.

Introduction

What does Powermail for Developers do?

- Powermail for Developers is a plugin / flexform.
- The plugin / flexform inspects the powermail plugin, which is included on the same page.
- Powermail for Developers displays GET- and POST-parameters and session data, which are generated and used by the powermail plugin.
- Powermail for Developers is for TYPO3 developers.
- Powermail for Developers is useful,
 - if you want control the work flow of your extension depending on the state of a powermail form (i.e: create, edit, send)
 - if you want take data from the powermail form and handle the data in your extension.
- Powermail for Developers supports powermail 1.x and 2.x
- Powermail for Developers is supported by the DRS – the Development Reporting System.

What do you need?

- Powermail in version 1.x or 2.x

Quick Installation

- Install Powermail for Developers.
- Add the Powermail for Developers plugin / flexform to a page, which is used a powermail form.
- Configure the Powermail for Developers plugin / flexform.
- Inspect the report in the frontend.

Plugin / Flexform

The plugin / flexform has three tabs.

Information

Reports about the inspected powermail form.

Example for a report

This plugin handles the powermail form with the title "[Powermail]" and the uid #1622.

The powermail plugin has the confirm mode disabled.

Powermail version: 1.6.6 (internal 1006006)

BE AWARE: If you have more than one powermail form within the same page, you can get improper results. Even if all other powermail forms are hidden or if they have a deleted status.

Initiation

You have to add your current IP address to the list of the allowed IP. Without this IP you won't get a report in the frontend.

This protection enables to inspect a powermail form in an operating system.

Prompts

You can disable / enable prompts for

- GET-/Post-parameters
- session data

Debugging

If you have any unexpected result, you can inspect Powermail for Developers in the TYPO3 backend with the DRS – the Development Reporting System – and in the TYPO3 frontend with Firebug.

DRS – Development Reporting System

Inspect work-flow and errors

The DRS – Development Reporting System – enables you

- to follow the work-flow of Powermail for Developers,
- to inspect alternate configuration possibilities,
- to inspect unproper configuration and
- it prompts warnings and errors
