

Users manual

To display a RSS feed on the page :

Click on the page where the RSS feed should be displayed and create a new content element.



Choose the "Plugins" tab and then "RSS Feed Display".

Select this element type to insert a plugin which cannot be found amongst the options below.

Versatile news system for TYPO3

Create a non-cached Display Controller. This should be chosen only if needed, for example in case of a search function.
- RSS Feed Display**
Display a RSS feed on the Frontend



2. Define the number of items to be displayed
3. Tick if the item's description should be displayed
4. If number 3 is ticked, choose the description's length
5. Save and close
