

The TYPO3 Association

The TYPO3 Association is a non-profit organisation that was founded in 2004 to ensure the long-term development of the web-based content management systems TYPO3 CMS, TYPO3 NEOS and TYPO3 FLOW. More than 800 members, companies and freelancers have been supporting the association since then. Its funds come from membership fees, donations and the annual TYPO3 conference, T3CON.

In accordance with its statute, the TYPO3 Association supports the free software TYPO3 project under the GNU General Public License. The TYPO3 Association serves the general public by offering software developments from third parties free of charge.

The TYPO3 Association is an association in accordance with Swiss Law that is based in Baar ZG (Switzerland). It is non-partisan and denominationally neutral.

Products (TYPO3 Projects)

Most of TYPO3's projects focus on web-based content management systems (CMS) for enterprise users. Its main products are TYPO3 CMS, TYPO3 NEOS and TYPO3 FLOW.

- TYPO3 CMS is a free content management framework for websites and the most widespread open source CMS for enterprises. Approximately 500,000 websites have already been developed with TYPO3. TYPO3 CMS is based on the script language PHP. The current version is 6.2 LTS.
- TYPO3 Neos is the next generation open source content management system. The first version was published in December 2013 after 7 years of development time. With NEOS, editors can enter contents directly in the website without using forms or pop-up windows. The current version is TYPO3 NEOS 1.1.0.
- TYPO3 Flow is a PHP framework that was originally developed as a tool for TYPO3 NEOS. Flow serves as the basis for TYPO3 NEOS but can also be used for other projects.

Goals and tasks of the TYPO3 Association

The TYPO3 Association enables the further development of the products mentioned by creating the necessary basic conditions for open source software to be produced and further developed. These include events and educational offerings as well as infrastructural support. To be more specific:

- Informative and educational events on TYPO3 products and

projects

- Internal and external communication aimed at sharing knowledge and expertise on TYPO3
- Sustained and long-term development of the various TYPO3 projects
- Securing of trademark rights in the interest of the TYPO3 community

Official TYPO3 events

- TYPO3 Barcamps (open conferences with open workshops that are organised by the participants themselves), held several times a year in different cities
- T3CON: the annual TYPO3 conference for content managers, developers, business decision makers and marketing and IT experts held in Berlin from October 8 - 10, 2014. Roughly 400 participants are expected.
- T3 Developer Days, held each year for developers and users of TYPO3

Membership

The TYPO3 Association is a membership organisation. Our members pay an annual membership fee that is used to finance activities, events and projects. The members' names are published on the respective website (<http://association.typo3.org>). Sponsors support the various activities and thus round off the work of the TYPO3 Association.
